GREENCRAFTS at GLASTONBURY FESTIVAL

Each year Greencrafts issue an open-call for craftspeople, sculptors and crew to apply to be part of the Greencrafts Field at Glastonbury Festival of Performing Arts. Please see the Greencrafts Opportunities Listing for further information.

The field of approx 2 acres is made up of numerous workshop pitches showcasing traditional crafts plus interactive gardens, seating and sculpture. We work with a mixture of trusted experts and up and coming new blood to help the area remain fresh, current and contemporary. Places are limited and highly sought after meaning each year considerable numbers of applicants are unsuccessful so we stress the importance of the application procedure to help advance your chances of a place.

If you would like to apply, please check-out the website www.greencrafts.ie and read our Terms & Conditions before completing an application form with supporting letter/proposal and photos. Please tell us as much as you can about what you're offering with details of past relevant experience and include photos of your portable workspace/awning, craft/tools, artwork etc.

There are two application forms, please use the appropriate one. If you want to apply for more than one opportunity, please complete separate forms with supporting letters / photos.

- Craftspeople holding workshops
- Crew (including site crew / stewards / sculptors)

Please observe the deadline for receipt of applications (foot of application form). Application is by hard copy only. European airmail postage is needed if outside Ireland. Please be mindful post can take up to a week to arrive. Please use ordinary post as couriers do not deliver to the postal address.

Decisions are based on your application form and accompanying letter/photos.

All received applications will be replied to by e.mail.

Decisions will be either an offer of a place, a turn down or a waiting list place.

We need you to confirm acceptance of an offer within a stated timeframe (remember the waiting list!)

We do not use the telephone for enquiries. If you need to get in touch with a question, this can be done by e.mail via our website.
