GREENCRAFTS at GLASTONBURY FESTIVAL

These guidelines are for those interested in opportunities for craftspeople / site crew / stewards / sculptors as part of the Greencrafts Field at Glastonbury Festival of Performing Arts. June 22-26 2011

CRAFTSPEOPLE HOLDING WORKSHOPS

We're seeking craftspeople to hold public workshops in their own covered workspace from **Wed 22 to Sun 26** June inclusive, arriving on either **Sun 19 or Mon 20** to set up camp. We're seeking traditional crafts with an environmental bias. The appearance of your workspace is very important (tent type, signage, decoration etc.) We'll book several groups of the same crafts type if applications are strong enough. We're keen to work with people who've made traditional crafts part of their life or who are starting out. A limited selection of bursaries are available valued at 200 sterling each.

SITE CREW We're seeking site crew with experience of festivals / tree surgery / green building / working as part of a team with own tools, ideally with a chainsaw certificate. Arrival & set up of camp **Thur 16 June** & work **Frid 17 -Tue 21** (5 days). We'll provide meals. Limited bursaries of 250 cash sterling for crew with chainsaw & cert or 200 for crew without chainsaw / cert are available.

STEWARDS

We're seeking stewards with festival experience / good communication skills / reliability. You need to arrive to the festival on either **Mon 20 or Tue 21** June to set up camp. The steward's team will receive a Greencrafts briefing on **Wed 22** morning when all shift times will be sorted. All stewards MUST be present for this briefing. SHIFTS are from **Wed 22 to Sun 26** inclusive. Some days there is 24hr cover. Each steward is booked to work a 4 hr shift per day, for 5 days, in exchange for their ticket (20hrs). Shifts are worked in pairs. Very late night shifts get one meal, per shift done.

AFTER EVENT We're seeking to book 2 after-event stewards who will work informally all day on **Mon 27** after the event. Nic & Marie will brief them personally on their activities during the event.

SCULPTORS / LAND ART / GARDENS / SEATING

We're seeking sculptors / land artists / gardeners to bring/make robust works that make a big splash, with an environmental bias. You'd need to arrive to the festival with your work/tools on either **Sun 19 or Mon 20 June**. Your piece needs to be in place, safely & securely, by **Tue 21** for our health and safety check, and remain in place until after-dark on **Sun 26**. We'll locate a site for your artwork, somewhere within the Greencrafts field, as part of our overall site plan. *In some cases you may be asked to hold-off setting up until the crafts pitches around the site are in place, with the aim of both sculpture and crafts pitch being viewed at their best advantage.* Your piece will be 'in the arena' with you camped in the field next door with our stewards & other crew. You won't be able to see your artwork from your camp. Parking will be in the crew car park. Registered camper vans can apply to be on-site. A limited selection of bursaries are available valued at 200 sterling.

HOW TO APPLY / SUPPORTING INFO - PROPOSAL

To apply, please read the Greencrafts terms & conditions, + the guidelines before sending us either a CREW or a CRAFTSPEOPLE application form. On the crew form please circle CREW or SCULPTURE or STEWARD at the top. **ALL applicants need to include a supporting letter/proposal** with photos telling us about yourself, your past experience & any relevant qualifications/training etc. If you are applying for a bursary or crew expenses please make this clear on the application form.
